

Please ask, if you wish, for copies of the wording below. Complete documents are available on the Hills Juniors website. References to "The League" below mean Hills Junior Baseball Association and this Club, jointly and severally.

Parents (and other appropriate adults)...

Registration requires you to surrender many of your rights at law as they affect both you and your child. We're not happy with that but it's a fact of life. See "Notice regarding Insurance Cover" below. If you're unhappy with this situation, your only option is {sadly} to refuse to register your child.

- (1) I acknowledge a responsibility to ensure that my child's health and general fitness are appropriate to the activities involved, including both training and playing.
- (2) I authorise The League or its officials to procure medical care for my child should the need arise, and to do so in my stead without the right to hold The League or its officials culpable for the results of such care if found to be inadequate or negligent.
- (3) Upon request, I will provide a Birth Certificate or other documentation to prove my child's birth date.
- (4) I will remit any moneys assessed by The League as payable in respect of my child's participation in any activities controlled by The League.
- (5) I will return, upon request, any uniform items or other equipment provided to my child by The League or this Club, or alternately will provide compensation for the loss of any such items, at a monetary value assessed by The League.
- (6) I will indemnify The League and this Club jointly and severally against all claims, demands, suits and any actions whatsoever brought by any person against The League or an Affiliated Club arising from loss, damage to property or injury to any person intentionally caused by my child while participating in any activity organised by The League or an Affiliated Club.
- (7) I warrant that my behaviour at League activities, and that of other family members and friends, will be non-confrontational, benign and unlikely to bring the game into disrepute.
- (8) I have been given the time and opportunity to read and understand both this document and the other relevant policies of The League before assenting to this Agreement.

NOTICE REGARDING INSURANCE COVER

Insurance cover provided is necessarily limited due to the costs involved. All members, including parents of players, are encouraged to visit the ABF website at www.baseball.com.au to view a copy of the Insurance Handbook which fully describes the cover provided.

PLAYERS - your Code of Conduct...

As an individual and team member, I will -

- (1) Work hard for myself and my team at all times. I will cooperate with my own team officials and with teammates and opponents, and obey any reasonable request from my team coaches or manager.
- (2) Play by the rules of the competition, and follow all recommendations of The League regarding safe play and equipment, and obey the rules prohibiting banned substances.
- (3) Never argue with an umpire and always accept the decisions of the umpires as being fair and called to the best of their ability.
- (4) Control my temper. I recognise that swearing or verbal abuse of umpires, team officials or other players will not be tolerated. I will not abuse equipment (mine or anyone else's). I will not throw bats or helmets or other equipment.
- (5) Not cause any loss or damage to private property or cause a disturbance to others.
- (6) Not invite anyone other than team personnel into restricted areas such as the dugout.
- (7) Behave in a polite and appropriate manner towards others. I will applaud all good plays from either team, and treat all players, as I would like to be treated. I will not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of any other player, nor deliberately distract or provoke an opponent.
- (8) Be frank and honest with my coach concerning illness or injury and my ability to take part in training sessions or games.
- (9) Be responsible for my personal appearance, behaviour, personal hygiene and cleaning of my own equipment. I will be neat and tidy in appearance at games, training sessions and at any time that I am in public as a baseball player.
- (10) Be prompt for meetings, training sessions and games, and if I can't attend on time (or at all) then I will call my team manager or coach and say so, as soon as I can.

NOTICE REGARDING PUBLISHING OF YOUR CHILD'S IMAGE ON THE INTERNET

PRIVACY STATEMENT

We respect your privacy. The information you provide will be used to provide services for you and for the purposes of registration, participation, team selection and insurance. It will be passed onto the Hills Junior Baseball Association (HJBA), the NSW Baseball League (NSWBL) the Australian Baseball Federation (ABF) and to the ABF's insurer. Your information may also be shared with organisations associated with the sport of Baseball, including but not limited to the Australian Sports Commission and Australian Sports Drug Agency. HJBA, NSWBL and the ABF may at times ascertain whether or not we have services or products, which may foreseeably meet your needs and may notify you about these. We will not however, share your personal contact details with any third party for their commercial use. If you do not provide the information we may not be able to register you as a member. We, HJBA, NSWBL and the ABF comply with the Privacy Act with respect to the collection, storage and security of your personal details.
