Uniform Items

Uniform items (pants, belts, socks, caps, mitts) can be ordered on Registration Day (see Order Form).

Registration fees include rental of a game shirt and pants for Tee Ball and Modball, and a game shirt for all other players. Please note that all shirts and pants are on loan to players and ***must be returned to the team manager at the last game played***. If shirts are lost or damaged a charge may be applied.

All registered junior club members will receive a Kolts training shirt, which must be worn to all training sessions and game days.

Club Support

Our club is an organisation run by volunteers. We need your support in order to enable the sport and our club to continue. Please do your bit throughout the season, whether it is in the canteen, scoring, managing or setting up the fields. Also, ***please*** consider becoming a part of our Committee, as we desperately need new members to assist us running the club. Our meetings are held at 7.30pm in the clubhouse on the third Tuesday of each month.

Duties Roster

Rosters will be prepared assigning families to canteen and ground set up duties at Kellyville Baseball Park. Rosters will be made available to all families as soon as the draw is available. ***Participation in these duties is a condition of registration.*** Only one family member is required to complete the assigned duty. It is ***your*** responsibility to arrange a swap of duties with another family if necessary and to also notify your team manager.

Team Management

All teams will require a:

- **Coach** – to co ordinate the growth of players’ skill levels and knowledge of the sport.
- **Manager** – to ensure the details related to “game day” are organised and communicate club activities to team members.
- **Umpire** – to officiate at games and to encourage fair competition in the sport. Base umpires are mandatory at all away games.
- **Scorer** – to accurately record the details of the game.
- **Extra Parents** – to assist in monitoring participants at training.

All coaches, managers and other adults involved with junior teams are required to complete a Prohibited Employment Declaration Form to ensure Child Protection guidelines are met.

Previous experience is not essential, as training and information will be given to assist you in carrying out these rewarding tasks.

Insurance

Limited insurance cover is provided under master policies arranged by the Australian Baseball Federation. The cover that is provided under these policies is limited and if you desire further information you should visit the ABF website at www.baseball.com.au or you can access the link through the Kellyville Kolts website. Unfortunately, the costs involved in insurance have increased over recent years and the controlling bodies have responded to this by reducing coverage and/or raising premiums. If you desire further insurance coverage, you should make private arrangements (individual cover increases may not be available under the master policies).

Privacy Statement

We respect your privacy. The information you provide will be used to provide services for you and for the purposes of registration, participation, team selection and insurance. It will be passed onto the Hills Junior Baseball Association (HJBA), the NSW Baseball League (NSWBL), and the Australian Baseball Federation (ABF) and to the ABF’s insurer. Your information may also be shared with organisations associated with the sport of Baseball, including but not limited to the Australian Sports Commission and Australian Sports Drug Agency. We will not however, share your personal contact details with any third party for their commercial use. If you have any privacy concerns or would like to verify any information we hold about you, please contact your Club Secretary, the President of HJBA, or the privacy officers at NSWBL or the ABF, as appropriate.
